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### **Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command Awards Contract**

SAN DIEGO – Data Link Solutions, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, is being awarded an \$18,461,448 firm-fixed-price contract and delivery order for Multifunctional Information Distribution System-Low Volume Terminals (MIDS-LVTs). The MIDS-LVT provides secure, high capacity, jam resistant, digital data and voice communications capability for Navy, U.S. Marine Corps, Air Force and Army platforms. This delivery order combines purchases for the U.S. (33 percent) and the governments of Saudi Arabia (38 percent), Finland (27%) and the Republic of Korea (3 percent) under the Foreign Military Sales Program.

Work will be performed in Wayne, N.J. (50 percent), and Cedar Rapids, Iowa (50 percent), and is expected to be completed by Jan. 31, 2015.

No contract funds placed on this contract will expire at the end of the current fiscal year.

This contract was competitively procured under a multiple award contract (MAC) with two proposals solicited and two offers received via the SPAWAR E-commerce website. The synopsis was released via the Federal Business Opportunities website for the initial MAC awards.
