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### **Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command Awards Contract**

SAN DIEGO – ViaSat, Carlsbad, Calif., is being awarded an \$18,050,312 firm-fixed-price delivery order for Multifunctional Information Distribution System-Low Volume Terminals (MIDS-LVTs). The MIDS-LVT provides secure, high capacity, jam resistant, digital data and voice communications capability for U.S. Navy, U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Air Force and U.S. Army platforms. This delivery order procures MIDS-LVTs for the U.S. only.

Work will be performed in Carlsbad, Calif., (30 percent), in various other sites worldwide (70 percent), and is expected to be completed by July 31, 2014.

Contract funds in the amount of \$402,756 will expire at the end of the current fiscal year.

This contract was competitively procured under a multiple award contract (MAC) with two proposals solicited and two offers received via the SPAWAR E-commerce website. The synopsis was released via the Federal Business Opportunities website for the initial MAC awards.
