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Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command Awards Contract

SAN DIEGO – Data Link Solutions, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, is being awarded a \$6,912,840 firm-fixed-price contract and delivery order for Multifunctional Information Distribution System-Low Volume Terminals (MIDS-LVTs). The MIDS-LVT provides secure, high capacity, jam resistant, digital data and voice communications capability for U.S. Navy, U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Air Force, U.S. Army platforms and other foreign users worldwide. This delivery order is for the government of Saudi Arabia under the Foreign Military Sales (FMS) Program.

Work will be performed in Wayne, N.J. (50 percent), Cedar Rapids, Iowa (50 percent), and is expected to be completed by Dec. 31, 2015.

No contract funds placed on this contract will expire at the end of the current fiscal year.

This contract was a sole source directed by the FMS country with one proposal solicited and one offer received via the SPAWAR E-commerce website.
